Tryouts: February 7th from 4pm to 5pm at HB Rinks. Students will wear full gear to tryouts.

Teams: We will have one team playing in the JV division. The team is co-ed and with 6th, 7th and 8th graders. The teams we play will be coed with 5th – 8th graders mixed on the team.

Coaches: Brennan Lee is Head Coach and Jonathan Radcliffe is Assistant Coach.

Athletic Packet is due March 1 for those that have not already turned one in this school year. That includes a physical from within the last year.

Player Fee: \$125 for hockey and will be automatically withdrawn on February 28.

AAU Membership: all players have to get an AAU membership to play. It is \$14. www.aauhockey.org

Gear: We will provide shin guards, elbow pads, gloves, helmet and a stick for those that need it. This equipment needs to be returned at the end of the season. Players need to have their own skates and pants. They may also use a girdle and mouth guard if they would like. We will also provide jerseys and give those out later in February.

We have goalie gear/sticks for those interested, but we keep that with the team.

General Information for those unfamiliar with the league

Our Roller Hockey team is different from our other school teams because it is a different league. It is through the Ducks organization. All games are played at the Rinks in HB, Irvine or Corona (we go to Corona once if at all). Game start times will either be 4pm or 4:30pm and will last about an hour. There are about 9 games in a season and then playoffs. Playoffs are all day on a Saturday in late May. We have few practices because we don't have a rink and it is difficult to schedule rink time. Practices are scheduled by the coach as the season goes and will be at the HB Rinks. It is not a set practice schedule.

We are given the game schedule the last week in February by the Ducks and then games start beginning of March. There are often changes in the beginning of the season as they shift teams to place them in appropriate divisions. I cannot guarantee that these games won't conflict with our other HCS Spring sports. You have to be able to flexible with hockey as you have to go in knowing we won't know schedules until the last minute. That also means coaches are flexible knowing players may have to miss some games due to scheduling conflict. We all just communicate and work together 😊
